To develop students' critical reasoning skills in the context of international financial risk management.

To equip students with the practical skills required of financial managers in international companies.

- Be able to critically assess the business and financial risks faced by companies with international operations. Be able to describe the issues involved in international taxation.
- A systematic understanding of foreign exchange markets and how the foreign exchange risk is managed.
- Application of relevant knowledge to a range of situations in an international valuation and investment context.
